You are continuing to grow and build an amazing future. We are already proud of all that you have accomplished and will accomplish. With that, the Night of Superstars/SCC* Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce the open call for scholarship applications for its Winter/Spring 2024 session.

Note: These scholarships will be awarded at the Night of Superstars DFW 2025 red carpet event in Dallas, Texas on November 1, 2025. Please make plans to attend so that we can celebrate our recipients in person and on stage.

The Committee will be awarding up to five (5) scholarships during this application period. They are:

- The Inspiration Scholarship, \$2,500. Awarded to the highest score during this scholarship application period.
- The Perseverance Scholarship, \$2,250. Awarded to the second highest score during this scholarship application period.
- The Resilience Scholarship, \$2,000. Awarded to the third highest score during this scholarship application period.
- The Bravery Scholarship, \$1,750. Awarded to the fourth highest score during this scholarship application period.
- The Champion Scholarship, \$1,500. Awarded to the fifth highest score during this scholarship application period.

To be considered for a scholarship, you must meet eligibility and complete the following:

- Scholarship Application for the Fall 2025 scholarship session
- Short Answer Responses, prompts located in application
- Scholarship Essay, prompt located in application
- GPA verification or similar type of verification of standing in continuing education pathway
- Letter of Recommendation, guidelines located in application

Scholarship applications for the Fall 2025 session are due by 11:59pm on October 26, 2025.

Scholarship package should be emailed as one complete package to scholarships@nightofsuperstars.org. You will receive an email confirmation that it was submitted.

IMPORTANT:

- Only fully completed applications will be considered. Be sure to verify that you have all elements of the application attached before submission.
- Only applications submitted to the proper channel listed above will be considered.
- If you do not receive a confirmation email (generally sent once per week during the open call period), please resubmit your application prior to the deadline.

Application Eligibility

Scholarship considerations are available to all individuals who have been:

Inducted into Night of Superstars prior to the application deadline;

AND

Have either currently enrolled in a minimum of one (1) semester/term of their continuing education opportunity (i.e. college, university, trade school, performing arts training course and/or life skills training course) or will be graduating high school before June 15, 2024 and beginning their continuing education opportunity by the Fall 2024 semester;

AND

Applicant has not already been awarded a Night of Superstars/SCC* Scholarship within the previous four (4) years;

AND

Applicant currently has a 3.0 or higher GPA at their current educational level, whether it be high school senior GPA, college/university GPA or similar standing at their trade school, performing arts training course or life skills training course opportunity.

Acceptance window and deadline for receipt of scholarship applications in this period:
Superstars inducted prior to October 13, 2025 into Night of Superstars, accepting applications until deadline: October 26, 2025 at 11:59pm (central) email timestamp receipt

Application must be submitted to <u>scholarships@nightofsuperstars.org</u> and may be disqualified if submitted to any member of the Night of Superstars/SCC* Scholarship Committee directly or any other member of the Night of Superstars organization

Refer to the application for supporting documents (i.e. essay page, evidence of GPA, Teacher letter of recommendation, etc), as required

Type or print legibly

Do not alter the application form in any way

Superstar applicant's name and address will be blind to the voting members of the Night of Superstars/SCC* Scholarship Committee to assure that each will be graded fairly and for their merit

Applications do not include financial family income to be placed as a question or requirement and therefore, is not used in determining awardees

Superstars NOT chosen for an award during the current scholarship application period may reapply in the next open application period; no applications will carry over to the next open application period automatically

Any previous Night of Superstars/SCC* Scholarship awardee may reapply four (4) years after the award period for which the Superstar was awarded

Scholarship review and voting is done and made solely by the Night of Superstars/SCC* Scholarship Committee, not to include Night of Superstars Founder
